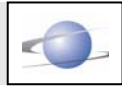

Our Mission

To provide a rigorous educational program that prepares students for success in college and helps develop the technical skills and personal qualities necessary for a successful career in aviation and business.

Our Vision

Enrollment

Eighty students are currently enrolled and 80 to 100 students will be enrolled each year to reach a total student body of no more than 400. We do not charge tuition and we have no admission requirements. Oakland Aviation High School does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or disability.

Educational Program

Students will receive a comprehensive, rigorous college preparatory education and technical training at the College of Alameda's award winning Aviation Maintenance Technology program. The educational program highlights an emphasis on literacy and numeracy across the curriculum, close parent partnerships and the use of multiple assessments to guide and direct instruction.

Management, Organization, and Ownership

Oakland Aviation High School is a public charter managed in partnership with the College of Alameda. The school opened September 11, 2006 at 7850 Earhart Road at Oakland International Airport's North Field. A governing board monitors implementation of the memorandum of understanding between Oakland Aviation High School and its partners. Oakland Aviation High School contracts with EdTec, a reputable outsourced charter school business services company for back-office business functions.

Founding Organizations

The Oakland Aviation High School Design Team was formed in 2002 through a partnership with Oakland Community Organizations, the Port of Oakland, the College of Alameda with participation and support from the Tuskegee Airmen, Western Aerospace Museum, Oakland Unified School District, EC Reems Academy of Technology and Art, and committed individuals who are parents, educators, pilots, airline mechanics and business people.

Financial Responsibilities

When Oakland Aviation High School is fully enrolled with up to 400 students in ninth to twelfth grades, it will be able to stand on its own financially with funds from State of California Average Daily Attendance (ADA) payments. This base per student amount will be supplemented by State and Federal categorical funds. In addition, OAHS has received start-up grants from CDE and the Walton Foundation. The governing board will write proposals to foundations, corporations and individuals to cover the funding gap as the school grows to full capacity.
